

How can I protect myself against shark attacks?

The best way to protect yourself against a shark is to study the behavior and gain as much knowledge and experience with sharks as possible. They suggest the following:

1. Avoid swimming, surfing or surface activities in close proximity to seals or sea lions in areas where great white sharks are known to roam. There is a small chance you could be mistaken for food by the great white.

2. Do not enter the water if you have an open wound.

3. When we enter the water we are sharing the ocean with animals that make it their home. Always apply common sense and most importantly, respect the shark like you would any other animal in the wild.
